

SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

- BOATS MUST BE SAFE, SEAWORTHY, AND APPROPRIATE FOR OPEN WATER.
- PADDLERS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR A PFD AND HAVE A WHISTLE ON THEIR PERSON.
- ALTHOUGH SAFETY BOATS WILL BE ON THE COURSE, RACERS MUST BE CAPABLE OF SELF-RESCUE IN ANY CONDITIONS THAT MAY BE PRESENT ON RACE DAY. USE GOOD JUDGEMENT AND BE HONEST ABOUT YOUR ABILITIES FOR THE CONDITIONS.
- SURFSKIS, OUTRIGGER CANOES AND STAND-UP PADDLEBOARDS MUST HAVE A FUNCTIONAL LEASH ATTACHING PADDLER TO CRAFT.
- RECOMMENDED: HIGH VISIBILITY CLOTHING, VHF RADIO/CELL PHONE.
